Falling and tripping	Public and staff	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tidy up props and equipment when not in use.• Ask public to put equipment back when finished.• Always supervise use of props and equipment.• Participants not to use unicycles, stilts, wobble boards and tight wires without prior consent at public events• First aid trainer at hand if accident occurs.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Learning to ride a unicycle involves continuous falling off until balance is found, so will always require close supervision	
Cuts and burns	Public and staff	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Supervise equipment to ensure it is used correctly.• Equipment maintained and regularly checked for the safety of users.• First aid trainer at hand if accident occurs.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Workshops do not include fire juggling or knife juggling	

Being knocked over	Smaller children	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Avoid overcrowding, Limited numbers per session/instructor. • Space to be assessed to ensure sufficiency. • Children must be always supervised by an adult. • Different sessions in place for different ages. 	We do not permit small children and older children, teenagers and adults to participate at the same time.
Tightwire Falling/slipping	Public and staff	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tightwire always supervised by competent member of staff. • Staff assisting participant by holding hand. • Team member to be fully trained. • First aider at hand. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure staff are aware of movements on tight wire always.
